DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. <u>iReady Instruction</u>

Mrs. McDonald reported that the district uses i-Ready Diagnostic Assessments to assess current level, identify learning gaps, and to measure student growth. Clawson has been renewing and purchasing its assessment licenses on a yearly basis. The district has a proposal from Curriculum Associates for \$14,675.68 to provide 1 year of assessment licenses for TK-12 assessment.

The district would like to continue to utilize the iReady instruction program for Middle School students to address reading and math learning gaps. Purchasing licenses for students to use during the school day and after school will allow for teachers to have access to a tool that will directly address the areas of need that have been identified by the iReady Diagnostic. The district has a proposal from Curriculum Associates for \$9,755.52 for a middle school site license.
