


CLAWSON BIKE BUS FAQ



Q | What is the Bike Bus?

A | Riding bikes to school to promote health/wellness, safety on our campus (less cars) and positive school culture and community.

Q | Where does the Bike Bus go?

A | We've split the city into FOUR quadrants, each with its own route. Routes can be found [HERE](#). But anyone is invited to join any route by getting dropped off at our starting location or join in if we pass by your house.

Q | Who can participate?

A | Any CHS, CMS or CES student. Parents are welcome as well. The more the merrier!

Q | Can I ride a scooter or motorized bike?

A | In an effort to remain on time and safe, no scooters or motorized bike or vehicle of any sort is allowed. Traditional pedal bikes only please.

Q | Are our bikes safe while we're at school?


A | Our Bike Bus will end at the tennis courts, which is where we'll safely house them for the day.

Q | Can I participate in all four days/routes?

A | Yes! If you would like to join all four days, simply get dropped off at any of the starting points or join along the route.

Q | What should I wear?

A | **Helmets are required and need to be worn at all times.** Other than that, tennis shoes are a smart choice.

Q | What do we do after school?

A | The Clawson Bike Bus will depart the tennis courts at 3:20 and follow our same route back to our original meeting location. If students do not want to bike home and parents choose to pick them up that is ok. If CHS or CMS students would like to leave on their own earlier than 3:20 that is fine.

Q | What if there's inclement weather?

A | If there is inclement weather, we will communicate that via our School Messenger text messaging system by 7:00 am. We will reschedule for an alternate day.

Q | What will CES students do between 7:45 and the start of school?

A | They will be supervised at all times by CES staff and PTO at the tennis courts and will be escorted to their respective drop-off doors at 8:00 am, where they will continue to be supervised.

Q | Who will supervise the Clawson Bike Bus?

A | Mr Shell, along with other CPS staff, will be joining and supervising along the entire route. Additionally, our school SRO, Officer Brozich, will be accompanying us along the route in her official CPD vehicle.

Q | Crossing 14 Mile, Main St and Rochester Rd.

A | We will cross at the safest crosslight along the route, and Officer Brozich will move her CPD vehicle to the intersection while we cross.

Q | Will we continue the Clawson Bike Bus in the Spring?

A | Absolutely! We anticipate the Clawson Bike Bus being a great success and will build on this program into the spring.
