As we prepare for the 2025-2026 school year, we want to remind families that the funding for free meals for all students has not yet been finalized with the state. While the Michigan Schools Meals Program provided free meals last year, we are still awaiting guidance on whether that will continue.

In the meantime, it is still important that you fill out a free/reduced meal application: A school's eligibility for federal Child Nutrition Programs such as Summer Food Service Program and others is based on free and reduced-price eligibility.

Students and families may qualify for other program fee reductions based on their eligibility for free or reduced-price meals. Federal and state education finding uses free and reduced-price eligibility.

Please complete the 2025-2026 online application through your MISTAR Parent Portal account. A paper application can be downloaded on the Clawson Public Schools Food Service Department web site Forms and Documentation.
